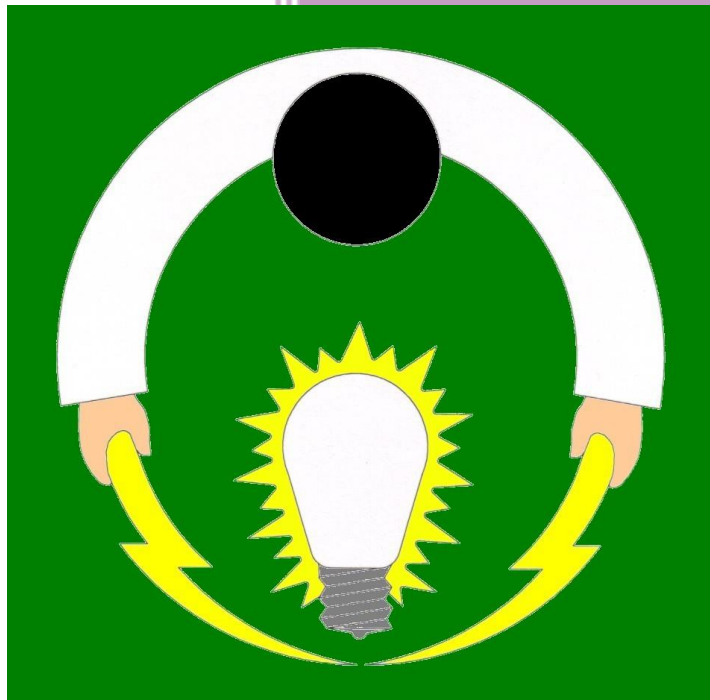

A. Lifeline Income Augmentation
